Our mission is to provide a safe, comfortable, body positive, clothing optional, men only space for men who enjoy social nudism to experience in the company of other, like-minded men.

AS A PRIVATE CLUB; MANAGEMENT HAS THE RIGHT TO DENY MEMBERSHIP OR TO REVOKE ANY MEMBERSHIP.

Member Qualifications

Members must be male.

Members must be 18 or over.

Members must have valid government issued ID with a photograph and date of birth. Members must support the mission of providing a safe, comfortable space for men to enjoy social nudism with other men.

Members must respect the privacy of all members.

Members must read and sign the MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT.

MUTUAL RESPECT

No one will interfere with another member's right to enjoy his time at TPL. There will be no harassing, or bullying.

People have a right to their bodily autonomy. Touching someone in a sexual way without consent is sexual assault.

Repeatedly trying to get someone to engage in sexual activities is harassment.

Following someone throughout the property is harassment. Spreading rumors about another member is harassment. Making derogatory comments about a member's appearance or body is not respectful and violates TPL's body positive mission.

BASIC RULES

No illegal activities.

No illegal drug use.

No prostitution/solicitation

No violent behavior.

No overly offensive behavior.

No fireworks, no weapons.

No glass bottles.

USE OF POOL & SPA

There is no lifeguard on duty.

You must shower before using either.

Shower with soap and rinse well.

No lotions or lubes can be used in or around the pool and/or spa.

No diving.

FEES AND DUES

As a Members Only Social Club we collect membership dues each year in the amount of \$40. Your yearly membership is a period of 365 days from the day you pay your dues. Twin Ponds Lodge is closed every January and February.

Day Passes and lodging fees are not included in membership dues.

Upon arrival to the property, you must come to the office and check-in.

Day Pass fees or lodging fees are due upon arrival.

Day passes are for the day and expire when the lodge closes. If your plans change and you decide to remain on the property overnight you must go to the office, update your check-in, and additional fees may be required.

VEHICLES & PARKING

The speed limit in the camp is 10 mph. Only one vehicle can be parked at each RV site. Only one vehicle can be parked at each cabin. Tent sites can have one vehicle parked at the site but it is preferred that you unload and then move your vehicle to the parking along the drive. Members on a Day Pass must park along the driveway.

MISCELLANEOUS

Do not feed the wildlife. Pick up after your dog. Pick up after yourself. Trash must be put in the trash receptacles. Do not flush condoms. Do not flush anything other than septic safe toilet paper. Put bottles and cans in the recycling receptacles. Do not burn plastic. Do not use lighter fluid to start your campfire. Completely extinguish your campfire before leaving it unattended.

PHONES & PHOTOS

Absolutely no recording devices are allowed in the Bear's Den, this includes cell phones. If you take a photograph at the Lodge you can not capture anyone else in the photo that has not given you permission to take his photograph.
