



ALCOHOL & BEVERAGE POLICY

ALCOHOL: TPL has a liquor license and we must abide by Maine State laws regarding the service of alcohol. We will not serve alcohol to anyone under the age of 21. We will not serve intoxicated persons. Alcohol served at from the bar must stay within the service area. You can not bring beverages from the lodge outside, to your tent site, or to your cabin, not even something as simple as a cup of coffee. The only exception would be a sealed bottle of soda or water purchased in the shop.

BYOB: You can BYOB to the campground. In fact you should BYOB if you wish to have a beverage at your campfire or outdoors on the property. Our service area only covers the lodge and a small, designated area outside. We provide refrigerators in the cabins and travel trailers, there is also a refrigerator outside near the main entrance that you are welcome to use for your BYOB beverages. We also provide you with free ice and free cups. ALL BEVERAGES brought to the campground must remain outside of the lodge and outside of the service area. Even something as simple as a cup of coffee or a bottle of water must not cross the line between service and non service area. We have free coffee and water stations inside and outside the lodge.
